



Resolution 00.5.2 – Institute Five Day Flex Format:

May 15, 2000

Whereas Flex Days are intended as a way for faculty to accomplish tasks relevant to the instructional program, and

Whereas Mesa College has only one flex day for next year when 15 flex days are allowable, and

Whereas numerous department/discipline tasks need immediate attention, such as writing new course curriculums, revising course outlines into the integrated course outline format, improving instructional delivery methods using multi-media, exploring distance education possibilities, and maintaining currency within the discipline,

Therefore be it resolved that Mesa College institute five flex days for the 2001-2002 college instructional calendar, and

Be it further resolved that the Academic Senate appoint an ad hoc committee to work with the Vice President of Instruction to determine the structure of the resulting shorter instructional calendar and recommend distribution and ways to utilize the increased number of flex days.
