



Resolution 97.11.4 – Program Review (Clear and Consistent Process for Allocating Funds to Schools within San Diego Mesa College): Gary Holton

November 3, 1997

Whereas in the new campus budget structure, money, including equipment funding and "block grants," is given directly to the schools,

and, whereas there is no clearly defined campus-wide process for allocating these funds within the departments and disciplines of the schools,

and, whereas the academic mission of the college is best served when clear and fair processes are employed,

and, whereas faculty are recognized by the legislature as the experts in instruction,

Be it therefore resolved that the Academic Senate directs its Executive Committee to draft a clear and fair process for allocating these funds given to the schools.

Be it further resolved that the department chairs, as representatives of the Academic Senate, should be at the core of this process.
