



**Resolution 98.3.2 – Standards for Technology in Classroom Instruction:** McLeod

March 28, 1998

The San Diego Mesa College Academic Senate affirms the established professional principle that faculty determine not only the content but also the delivery of curriculum in higher education classroom teaching.

Individual faculty members, in conjunction with colleagues in their discipline within the San Diego Community College District, as part of curriculum review and in keeping with professional guidelines, shall establish standards for the application or use of technology in various instructional areas;

All initiatives for incorporation of technology in the educational process will be defined by faculty.

Arrangements for the provision of all instructional technology through partnerships (either directly or indirectly) between the San Diego Community College District and the private sector shall be negotiated with full participation by the Academic Senate and relevant discipline area faculty throughout all stages of the process.

No expectations shall be imposed upon individual faculty members requiring the use of any particular technology in their instruction, unless mandated by law or by a professional body in compliance with accreditation/licensing requirements.
