 - a. REASONS FOR:**
 - I. LOW PROGRAM ENROLLMENT – AVERAGES APPROXIMATELY 10 STUDENTS PER YEAR. UNABLE TO CONTINUE USING NUTR 150 AND 180 DUE TO AN ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENT THAT COURSES IN PROGRAM ARE ONLY TAUGHT BY REGISTERED DIETITIANS. SEVERAL CLASSES ARE OFFERED ON OTHER CAMPUSES TAUGHT BY NON-DIETITIANS AND WE ARE NOT ALLOWED TO RESTRICT STUDENTS TO ONLY TAKE CLASSES AT MESA.
 - II. DESIGNED NUTR 50 AND 60 TO ADDRESS CONCERNS WITH REGISTERED DIETITIANS AS INSTRUCTORS, BUT NOW HAVE ADDITIONAL LOW ENROLLED CLASSES. SOME REGISTERED DIETITIANS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY ARE NOT WILLING TO SUPERVISE STUDENTS FOR MANDATORY 15 HOURS DURING CLINICAL ROTATIONS UNLESS THEY ARE PAID BY THE COLLEGE TO DO SO.
 - III. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR FINANCIAL AID AS THE PROGRAM IS LESS THAN 16 UNITS.
