◆ Specific ◆ Measurable ◆ Achievable ◆ Relevant ◆ Time-Based

Specific: Describe a precise or specific outcome which is linked to a rate,

number, percentage or frequency

Measurable: Describe the system you will put in place to measure your progress

towards the achievement of your objective.

Achievable: Ask yourself the following two questions, "With a reasonable amount

of effort and application, can I achieve this objective?" and "Do I have control over the means by which I can achieve this objective?"

Relevant: Can you make an impact on the situation? Is it important to your

education? To your supervisor and to your employer?

Time-Based Clearly define your completion date. Give yourself plenty of time to

insure a completion date by the end of the semester.

Reference Cooperative Work Experience Education Student Manual When writing learning objectives you need to answer the following questions

- 1. What do I want to learn, change, or improve? See Action Word List in manual.
- 2. <u>How</u> will I learn, change, or improve it? See Learning Processes Word List in manual.
- 3. <u>How</u> will the results be evaluated or measured? See Measurement & Evaluation Word List in manual.
- 4. When will it be completed? State a month, day and year.

Examples of Effective Learning Objectives:

Present job is sales/support associate in a bookstore:

Objective: <u>Increase</u> sales by 3% in the Children's Department <u>by keeping</u> all displays current, stocked, and creative.

Evaluation Method: By increased book sales over a comparable time period.

Completion Date: April 1, 2015

Present job is sales/stocking clerk in a vitamin store:

Objective: Learn to inventory the supplements by organizing them by type and expiration date.

Evaluation Method: By before and after photos and supervisor's evaluation.

Completion date: May 1, 2015

Present job is bussing tables at a local restaurant:

Objective: Learn the breakfast, lunch and dinner menu by memorizing the menu and with the help of my supervisor.

Evaluation Method: By passing with 95% accuracy the restaurant's menu quiz given by my supervisor.

Completion date: March 15, 2015
