New Business

- Read article
- Make the language clear – plain language, the website should always have plain language – IT IS FOR EVERYONE IN THE PUBLIC DOMAIN.
- There are rules about what needs to be posted, but does all of it need to be front and center.
- Jennifer talked about how they are “chipping away” at the enormous amount of change that needs needed.
- Stay student focused on these changes as it is related to student equity but still a work in progress.

- Make recommendations to all that if you create a student-centered document you vet it against students.
- Where do the students start?
- Do you understand all of the words
- Do you know what this information is about

What can we do as a committee – where does our power come from, what are the process of change?

- What about a mini internal audit of information in your program.
- Flex workshop on language that you use with your students.
- Survey about what a student understands and does not understand.
- Mixer?
- How do we get the people who don't come to meeting or attend mixer to work to make the changes and create a space that allows for open discussion.
- Create some type of exercise that illustrates our challenges with language in our documentation and the lack of understanding that many student have with this material
- Need to plan a mixer on our language for EVERYONE in the institution.
- Example on complex language for each of use as homework to post on-line
