Student COVID-19 Process

Updated: 7/18/2022

Student Vaccination and Testing Requirements:

- SDCCD will no longer require students to provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test for in-person classes. The district will continue to strongly recommend that students get vaccinated and boosted.
 - The following classes still require vaccination. Enforcement will be at the local level within the department and students will be notified via the class schedule:
 - All Nursing and CNA Classes (City and College of Continuing Education)
 - All Allied Health Classes at Mesa College
 - EMT Courses at Miramar College:
 - EMGM 105A
 - EMGM 106
 - EMGM 296
- Effective immediately, vaccination information will be hidden from Campus Solutions.

Student Mask Requirements

- Mask requirements are still in effect at all district locations and district-sponsored events. Requirements may change depending on guidance from local, state, and federal health officials and county case rates/hospitalizations.

COVID Positive Student Protocols

- Students who are experiencing symptoms which may be related to COVID-19 will be advised to stay home and take a COVID test (PCR or antigen).
- Students who test negative for COVID-19 may return to campus as appropriate.
- Students who test positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, will be required to isolate off-campus for a **minimum of 5 days** and should consult with the Student Health Services Office for additional guidance and support.

- While in isolation, the student will be expected to re-test on Day 5 of the isolation period.
 - If the student tests positive on Day 5, the student will be required to remain isolated off-campus for an additional 5 days.
 - If a student tests negative on Day 5, the student must provide proof of the negative test (PCR or antigen) to the Student Health Services office to be cleared to return to campus on Day 6 or later.
- Students who choose not to test will be required to remain isolated off-campus for a minimum of 10 days unless otherwise advised by the Student Health Services Office.
- All students will be required to wear masks while on campus. Students will be asked to stay home if they have symptoms.

Contact Tracing

- Students who may have been exposed to COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, will be advised to watch for symptoms.
 - If symptoms appear, the student will be advised to take a COVID-19 test (PCR or antigen) and will follow the protocols listed above.
 - If no symptoms appear, the student is not required to take a COVID-19 test and may visit the campus as appropriate.
