

HOW TO TRANSFER WITH AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT)

WHAT IS AN ADT?

An Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) is a priority admission pathway to the **California State University (CSU)** system.

The ADT is intended for students who plan to complete a bachelor's degree in the corresponding major at a CSU campus. Each ADT is accepted by some, but not all, CSU campuses. All California Community Colleges offer different ADT degrees.

ASSOCIATE IN ART FOR TRANSFER (AA-T)

Anthropology, Art History, Communication Studies, Economics, Elementary Teacher Education, English, Geography, History, Journalism, Kinesiology, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish, Studio Art, and Theater Arts



ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE FOR TRANSFER (AS-T)

Biology, Business Administration 2.0, Computer Science, Geology, Mathematics, Nutrition and Dietetics, and Physics

SD MESA APPLY FOR GRADUATION STEPS

1. Send and evaluate transcripts from all previously attended colleges, if applicable.
2. Develop a comprehensive education plan with Counseling for your ADT.
3. Apply for Graduation via MySDCCD portal, under "My Academics" by **the ADT deadline.**

Students apply for graduation one semester before they complete requirements.



Students transferring in Fall with an ADT, must apply for graduation by February



Students transferring in Spring with an ADT, must apply for graduation by October

CSU TRANSFER APPLICATION STEPS

1. When applying to a CSU for transfer, choose the ADT option in the extended profile section of the application.
2. Select the CSU transfer program(s) that align with the ADT on your SDCCD education plan.
 - a. For Questions, connect with the Transfer Center
3. If it is required for your ADT, complete the fourth quadrant on the CSU application (requirements vary per school)
4. In January, update your CSU Application or SDSU Supplemental.

Please Note: If you apply with an ADT but were denied by your first-choice school, the ADT will guarantee you a spot at a CSU campus offering the same major. This campus may not be in the San Diego area. Check your student account on CalStateApply and all emails, including spam/junkmail.

PLANNING TO ATTEND COMMENCEMENT?

The Commencement Ceremony is the end-of-spring celebration in May for students that have completed or are projected to complete their degree/certificate requirements that school year. (Fall - Summer)

Updates on Commencement are shared in early spring. Be sure to check your email **after** applying for graduation for the information.
