The Transfer Academic Update (TAU) Opens December 15th. Students are required to update their Fall grades to maintain admission consideration.

**UC Application Fee Waiver:** The UC system will waive application fees for up to four campuses for students who otherwise would not be able to apply for admission. Students who qualify for fee waivers and who select more than four campuses must pay \$70 for each additional choice. To be accepted for the fee waiver program, a student's family income and size must fall within specific guidelines. The fee waiver program is for United States citizens, permanent residents, and applicants eligible for AB540 benefits. Students can apply automatically for a fee waiver within the online application. (Counselor Resources, 9/21)

Please note: Once the application has been submitted students cannot make any edits to content. They can make changes to their contact information and in January they will submit their Fall grades and make any changes to what they had initially planned for Spring. They cannot make any changes to PIQs, activities, courses for prior terms (before FA21) or add any other academic history. If they discover an error, they can add a comment in the TAU in January.
